Note 1: The only record of any of those interred in the Lindsley Vault is contained in a letter to the Trustees of the Church from Bertha Lindsley Lewis dated 7 Feb 1957 in which she makes reference to the fact that her brother Robert Lindsley Mather was the last person to be interred there before the vault was sealed. The original Deed for the Plot was executed by the Trustees to William Lindsley, Joseph B. Lindsley, Caleb F. Lindsley, and Mary Ann Lindlsey, the widow of Robert P. Lindsley. Mary Ann Lindsley 2nd married William Lindsley, the brother of her first husband. William Lindsley was Bertha Lewis Lindsley's step-grandfather. At the time the Vault was being placed, the excavation unearthed a number of brass buttons and fragments of blue cloth. Indications are that this was the site of a mass burial at the time of the smallpox epidemic in 1777.

Note 2: There is no evidence that Joanna P. Gardner Axtell, the 1st wife of Jacob Axtell is buried here. They were married 19 Jul 1826, and she died 18 Oct 1826.
