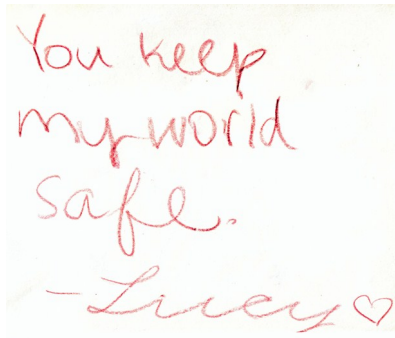

Military Ministry

This new ministry offers care and support to soldiers serving overseas and those who have recently returned home to New Jersey. Interfaith Food Pantry

IFP is a collection and distribution center for those unable to purchase food, which distributes about five tons of groceries each week to people in the Morristown area. Bring non-perishable items to the collection bin (located in the hallway to Sheffield Hall) at the Parish House. Suggested items include: low salt canned vegetables, dry and canned beans, low sugar canned fruits, canned meats and meals, cereal, pasta, hearty low salt soups, Parmalat (shelf stable 32 ounce size), brown and white rice (1 or 2 lb size), peanut butter, tea, diapers (size 4,5 & 6), spaghetti sauce.

Clothing Bank

Look for a tree in the Parish House in late November that has paper ornaments with requested gifts on it. Feel free to take an ornament and bring the unwrapped gift back to the Parish House by the date indicated. These gifts are for local Morristown families.

Community Soup Kitchen

There are several ways to have a positive impact on the folks who use the services offered by the soup kitchen (CSK). Some of them include: participating in the fall Hunger Walk, making breakfast meals for their guests to take away for another meal for themselves or other family members (e.g., a small box of cereal, shelf stable milk, fruit, granola bar, drink - Please call the CSK office to schedule a day for making meals - 973-267-0709), donating items to the CSK (suggested items – hearty meals in a can, canned fruit & vegetables, whole grain pasta, brown rice, oatmeal and cold cereal, cans of coffee, shampoo, soup, deodorant, white t-shirts L, XL & XXL, white socks, rain ponchos.)
